NEWSPAPERMEN INDICTED

Hans Ackermann and Max Keilbar, publishers of a newspaper printed in German at Taylor were indicted Monday in federal court. The charge is that they violated the oath of allegiance they swore to uphold and to renounce allegiance to any foreign government when they became naturalized citizens of the U. S. A. If convicted they will lose their citizenship papers and be sent to concentration camp. The F. B. I. has been investigating their books since June 10. Ackermann was in Germany on a visit at the outbreak of World War II.
