

Mr. and Mrs. Elmo Albrecht were injured slightly when their car was involved in an accident three miles west of Giddings on Highway 290 Sunday night.

The Albrecht's four and onemonth old daughter, Linda Gay was not hurt in the accident. Bennie Colburn if Austin, a passenger in the car, also was not hurt although he lost his shirt in the accident.

The Albrecht car was completely demolished when it struck a guard post on the highway shoulder and turned over, rolling down the embankment and landing against a tree.

The accident occurred about 10 o'clock Sunday night.

The three Albrechts were taken to Lee Memorial Hospital and later released. Mr. Albrecht returned to the hospital, however, Monday morning for additional treatment. Mrs. Albrecht and baby were recuperating this week at the home of her mother, Mrs. Emma Meschke in Giddings.

Mr. Albrecht said that a car ahead of him; alternately speeding up and slowing down, interfered with his driving, and as a result of trying to dodge the car he struck a guard post on the highway, causing him to lose control of his vehicle and turning over.

Officers this week were checking clues as to the identity of the car which Mr. Albrecht said interfered with his driving.
