

## Milton Archer Heads C of C

Milton Archer was elected president of the Giddings Chamber of Commerce at a meeting of the board of directors of the organization Monday night, May 23 at the Court House in Giddings.

M. C. Gruetzner was elected vice-president; Walter E. Kasper was re-elected secretary-treasurer. New officers will begin serving on July 1.

Mr. Archer succeeds Emil G. Richter who has served as president for the past year. Mr. Gruetzner succeeds Durwood L. Fuchs as vice-president.

Ordinarily in the Chamber of Commerce the vice-president is elevated to the position of president. Mr. Fuchs, however, withdrew his name from consideration for the office this year, giving his reasons for so doing in a letter to the board.

He pointed out that his term as a director was expiring this year and he did not feel that a man should serve as president

of the organization without also being a director. He also stated that his business duties would prevent him from performing the necessary duties of the office of president and that he felt he could better serve his community through his newspaper.
