Largest Bale of Cotton

The largest bale of cotton to be marketed in Giddings this season to date, was sold ~~Friday~~ by Henry Bamsch, who lives toward Warda. The bale weighed 717 pounds and brought \$216.80. The seed were valued at \$20.00 which would have brought a total of \$236.80.
