Alfred Bissell Injured

Alfred Bissell, 21-year old son of Mrs. Susie Bissell of Giddings, fell from a windmill tower Saturday evening and was seriously injured. His left wrist was broken and he was unconscious for three days. He was removed to a hospital in Austin where an examination was made and it was found that no bones of his skull were fractured, but that he was suffering from a concussion on the brain.

Alfred was on the platform of the windmill and caught hold of a pipe which was either broken off or unscrewed. He fell 20 feet to the ground. He was working on the farm with a Mr. Spencer a relative at Liberty Hill. Mrs. Bissell, Joe, and Angus went up there Sunday and returned Tuesday night reporting that he is improving. A speedy recovery is wished for him.
