LESTER BOONE ANNOUNCES FOR R. R. COMMISSIONER

Pledging himself to "an allout war effort," Lester Boone, Fort Worth Representative, has formally announced his candidacy for the Texas Railroad Commisson, and called attention to the fact that it was one of Texas' most vital factors in the war effort. He further pledged in his announcement to attend all commission meetines.

Boone, who is now serving in the Texas Legislature from Ft. Worth, sponsored the Omnibus Tax Bill which made possible the payment of old_age pensions, teachers retirement pay, aid to the blind, and aid to crippled and dependent children. As a member of the House Military Affairs Committee, he aided in the passage of the Texas Defense Guard Bill, which became a law, thereby giving Texas greater security in the present crisis.

"I pledge an administration of harmony and will cooperate, with other members of the commission," Boone said in his announcement. "I pledge myself to an all-out war effort in this vital department of State Government.
