

FIRST BALE FOR LEE COUNTY

The first bale of the 1921 crop was sold at Dime Box Tuesday. It was raised by Paul Czinsky on the Balcar farm on Dime Box prairie and it was ginned by Hannes Bros. The bale weighed 532 pounds and it was bought by Noah Albers of Dime Box at a premium price of twelve-sixty per pound.

The merchants of Dime Box gave other premiums consisting of a sack of flour, sugar, and merchandise.

Mr. Czinsky is one of Lee County's most prominent farmers and the News trusts that he will gather many more bales this season. The crop in that section is reported as being very short.

The bale was shipped to E. M. Collier of Giddings who bought the bale from Mr. Albers.
