Emmrich Mill Builds 'Skuscraper' Plant

Another "skyscraper" was added to the skyline of Giddings this week as the tower atop Emmrich Mill's new custom feed plant was completed. Other construction work on the building is progressing rapidly and will soon be far enough along for the installation of new machinery to begin.

Part of the present structure is being tied in with the new, which will give the plant an area of about 6300 square feet.

The tower will house a large cyclone collector, feed valves, and conveying and mixing equipment; also, a dust retaining compartment is provided for and designed for filtering out dust from air leaving the tower.

Les Emmrich, owner of the 37-year-old concern, states that the new facilities were carefully studied and planned to best conform to the needs of feeders of this area.

Equipment will be of the most modern design and will have some features that were still in the dream stage only a short time ago. Mr. Emmrich promises that he will have detailed and startling information on what this equipment will do when the plant is ready for production.

Walter Droemer Construction Co. of Giddings is in charge of building this plant.
