Edwin Durrenberger, an exstudent of G.H.S., spoke to one of Miss Bess Black's history classes February 9.

Edwin was working in the main office o fa Navy-sponsored school which gives the illiterate six weeks of training. Edwin stated that the average age of these students is 21 and 22 years old. Movies aid a great deal in the teaching. A college education for the boys in the Navy is carried on by correspondence.

Mr. Durrenberger also stated that college education is cheap in most Californian schools. For instance, at the University of California the tuition for a whole year is only \$200. The minimum semester tuition is \$14 at some of the colleges.
