Sept. 19, 1890

Last Tuesday evening at Deanville, Ed. Folkes while working at his gin, had his right arm terribly mangled. The engineer had shut the steam off, but the machinery was still in motion. Mr. Folkes who had been feeding the gin, raised the "breast" and for some reason put his hand under the gin saws when the arm was caught with the above results.
