On the back seat he brought 54 heads of home-grown lettuce which he sold for 7c a head. Fresh pork and hams from a hog killed the previous day, bringing \$8.45, took up more room, along with 45 dozen eggs. His \$50 check for whole milk during the month also helped out the pay roll. His dairy herd and poultry flock work along with clearing out scrub brush for permanent pastures and pecan trees budded to improve varieties are making life hard for him.
