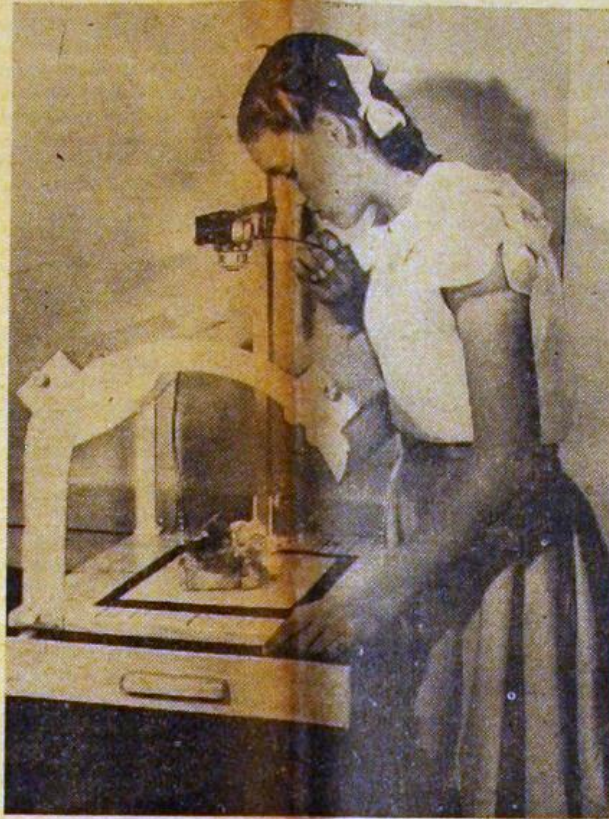

The Color Recorder is a visual teaching aid designed to make natural color photographing simple, easy and sure. Mr. A. Dee Glover, designer and manufacturer of the Color Recorder was formerly associated with the photography division of the University of Texas department of Physics, where in the teaching of photography, he recognized a growing demand for a device capable of simplifying the photographic problems of teachers and others interested in making educational pictures in natural

color. Mr. Glover built the first experimental model in 1947 and after refinements manufactured and sold several units. These were kept under observation for more than a year to test the design and customer demand. In the meantime he has been busy working out the problems and techniques of manufacture, some of which are quite new and still regarded as trade secrets. Production is now under way and distribution channels are being set up to cover the entire state with a reliable representative in each geographical area.
