## Auto Burns On Way To Schulenburg

Mr. Claude Graves, local barber, Mrs. Graves and Mr. Graves' mother were enroute to Schulenburg Sunday morning when the car a Plymouth sedan in which they were riding was destroyed by fire on the Giddings highway to LaGrange at the Rabb's Prairie road intersection.
