BOY SHOT

The eight year old son of F. H. Grimm of the Concord community was accidently shot by a 22 caliber rifle in the hand of a son of Ernst Ansohn of the same neighborhood. An operation was performed Sunday night and the bullet which had lodged in the appendix was removed.
