**RETURNS HOME**—Three year old James Haywood, one of Lee County's young citizens and son of Mrs. Kathryn Haywood of Giddings, has returned home after being a patient at Gonzales Warm Springs Foundation for a period of time. James was referred to this Texas hospital of physical medicine and rehabilitation following a siege of polio suffered during the summer of 1954 and has undergone an extensive series of treatments in an effort to overcome the handicaps wrought by this disease. A program of treatment has been set up for James' use while he is at home. The Gonzales Warm Springs Foundation, built and maintained through the support of interested Texans, is a non-profit, non-sectarian hospital, designed to benefit the handicapped people of our state.
