

New Pastor At Warda

Born at Copperas Cove, Texas, the new pastor to be installed at Warda Sunday, March 1, 1953 received his theological training at St. John's College in Winfield, Kansas and at Concordia Seminary St. Louis, from which he was graduated in 1934, after doing a years supply work at Cape Girardeau, Mo. He holds Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Divinity degrees.

After assisting the Rev. E. A. Heckmann at Riesel for some months he was called to Mart and also served Battle. In the fall of 1947 he was called to Hillsboro where he also served as Chaplain with the rank of Captain in the 36th. Division, Texas National Guard.
