

Area Corn Contest Awards Program to Be Held in Giddings

Awards to winners of the 45-county Area 4 Texas Hybrid Corn Contest will be made in a meeting in Fiddings on Friday, Dec. 16 at 1:30 p. m., according to County Agent Brown O. Spivey.

Five people from the area, including two from Lee County, will get cash awards for growing the best yield of corn on their test plots. All who produced 100 bushels of corn or more per acre and were entered in the contest, will get certificates for membership to the "100 Bushel Corn Club," Spivey said.

R. E. House of Dime Box who was first place winner in the area will receive \$50 cash. Billie Wiederhold of Dime Box 4-H Club will receive \$35 cash for second place in the area. The awards will be made at the meeting to be held at the Lee County Court House.

Other winners of cash awards in the area are Harold Whitened of Washington County, third place and \$25; George Boerger of Wharton County, fourth place and \$10; Glen Pomykal of Austin County, fifth place and \$5.

Lee County 4-H Club mem-

bers submitted more corn records than any other one county in the area, Spivey said.

"Many 4-H members are planning to attend the meeting. This is a good way to show the officials present that the program is liked and one should be planned for 1956," County Agent Spivey said.

All 4-H members in Lee County are urged to be present, and the general public also is invited.
