HORSE KILLED BY TRUCK

A commercial truck owned by the Sandgarten truck line of Elgin and driven by V. Jenkins of Elgin, collided with a horse and buggy owned and driven by Mrs. Guy Pearson who lives 2½ miles north of Ledbetter. It happened in Ledbetter at 8 o'clock Saturday night. The horse was killed outright but Mrs. Pearson was not injured, nor was the buggy smashed. Mr. Jenkins got his hand cut considerably by the windshield. He was driving slowly, otherwise the accident would have been more serious.
