**ALFRED JURISCHK
ACCIDENTALLY SHOT**

He thought to himself that it was lucky that no one was hit. About that time the boy gave notice that he was suffering and it was found that he had been hit by the bullet. He was given prompt medical attention and a speedy recovery is expected.
