FIRST BALE OF COTTON

Frank Krupa of Dime Box marketed the first hale of new cotton in Giddings late Friday afternoon, August 7. He heceived the \$25 cash premium. The bale classed as middlind and brought 7 1-2c weighing 511 lbs. Frank says his crop will be as good as that of last year when he gathered 13 bales off of 28 acres. He did not market the first bale of cotton last year, but the first bale he cold brought 10 1-2c. The bale last week was sold the day before the break in the cotton price. Had he been a day later, middling cotton would have been worth 5.85.
