

Myron Schneider Takes Top Honors With Gilt at 4-H Club Pig Show Here

The Sears pigs which will go to the Sears show in Austin next Tuesday, Sept. 19, were selected at the Fair Grounds last Saturday.

Myron Schneider of Immanuel Lutheran 4-H Club won first place with his gilt. This prize entitles him to \$10 in cash and the right to enter his gilt in the Austin show.

Second prize and \$8 went to Jimmy Stampport of Lexington. Third place went to Farrell Vahrenkamp of Immanuel Lutheran of Giddings. He received \$6 cash.

Fourth prize and \$4 went to Raymond Wendland of Fedor, and fifth prize and \$2 to Wilfred Koslan of Mannheim.

Sixth, seventh, and eighth places went to Daniel Leitko of Dime Box, Jack Shelton of Lexington, and Bobby Rodgers of Lexington, respectively.

Paul Kappler won first prize on his pen of three fat barrows. The cash prize amounted to \$12. This pen of barrows will also be entered at Austin. Paul raised these barrows out of the gilt he won from Sears last year.

In addition to these gilts and pen of barrows, the boar won by Randolph Woelfel of Lincoln will also be shown at Austin. Since this boar is the only Sears boar in the county, he was not shown at the Fair Grounds last Saturday.
