S. L. Lewis (colored) who lives near Giddings has kept a detailed account of his sales of milk and butter for the six months beginning January 1 and ending July 1. It showed that he had sold:

Milk amounting to	\$143.52
Butter amounting to	50.08
Total	\$193.60

He had sold some vegetables, but not many, so no record was kept of those sales. \$200 in six months go a "long ways" toward purchasing groceries.
