**PAIGE BOY TAKES FIRST
PLACE IN STATE MEET**

Otto Mattiza of the Paige High School placed first in the Rural Pentathlon in the State Meet on May 3. This accomplishment signifies that he is the best all-round athlete in the rural schools of the state. The Rural Pentathlon is a contest limited to rural schools and consists of five events—running broad jump, hop-step-jump, 100 yd. dash, shot put, and high jump. Otto won first place in the first two events, second in the next two, and third in the last, making a total of 21 points. His nearest competitor had 10 points.

Otto has graduated from Paige and plans to attend one of the near-by high schools next year.
