99-YEAR TERM AFFIRMED

H. W. Middleton of Smithville, convicted in Milam County of the murder of his father
and sentenced to 99 years in the
penitentiary, lost his second
appeal last week when the
Court of Appeals affirmed the
sentence. He was convicted of
placing strychnine in medicine
admisinistered to his father in
October 1927. The case was
tried in Milam County on change of venue. One of the chief
witnesses against Middleton
was Mrs. Rosa Waybourn, convicted and then acquitted of
plotting the death of her husband. Middleton had testified
against her. She in turn claimed Middleton had confided to
her he had poisoned his father.
