Died In Jail
Pedro Narro died Sunday night in the county jall. He ad two other Mexicans Jim and Cecil Roys had been jall- ed early in the night for an affray Sunday evening on the York farm near Loebau. Ped-
ro was a son of Steve Narro and had married a sister of the Roys during the first part of this year. There had been some difference between the families. The Narros lived on the Johnson place on Dime Box
prairie, and the Roys lived on the York farm. They were all at Roys Sunday afternoon. It is reported that some trouble a- rose between them. Narro was struck across the head with
what was supposed to have been the barrel of a gun, sep- arated from the stock, the part where the cartridge was placed being angular, cut a gash in his head. He was arrested and brought to jall, as were the
brought to jall, as were the other two, and he was given medical attention. The next morning he was found dead when breakfast was brought to the prisoners.
