Mr. Nitsche, who lives on Rt. 3, brought in the bale Friday afternoon. It was ginned at the Witte gin and was bought by Charlie Witte for 33 cents perpound. The bale weighed 543 pounds and classed middling, 15/16 inch staple.

Mr. Nitsche received a check for \$10 from the Giddings Chamber of Commerce for having the second bale.

Third bale to be brought to Giddings was to receive a check for \$5 from the Chamber, It had not been reported as received up to Tuesday gvening.
