Another Raid Made in Lee County

A squad composed of four Texas rangers and two deputy U. S. marshals made a raid about four or five miles south west of Lexington and found two stills, four barrels of mash and some beverage. John Noack and his son were taken in custody by the squad. Some of the apparatus was in a barn while other of it was in a pasture near some water. There was a trail leading to the place of operation, which was a path considerably beaten out by much use. The squad was well prepared with plenty of sawed-off shotguns, rifles and automatics, and they meet with no resistance. No one was found at one of the places of operation.
