**MOTOR BOAT FOR  
RESCUE WORK**

Phillips & Luckey displayed at the Lee County Fair their motor boat which they have put in operation during high-water emergencies to rescue people in the lowlands of Milam, Burleson and Lee counties. The boat will be ready for use at any time, it is needed for rescue work and will accommodate 24 persons when packed to capacity. With such a load, occupants must not rock the boat, otherwise it will capsize. The boat is a beauty, is 16 ft. long and is equipped with a 5 h. p. outboard motor. It recently rescued several families from the San Gabriel high waters.
