Marion Seale Bids For Office of Tax Assessor - Collector

The Giddings Star is authorized in this issue to announce the candidacy of Marion T. Seale as a candidate for the office of Assessor-Collector of Taxes, for Lee County, Texas.

Mr. Seale is a life long resident of Lee County, the son of Mrs. Ruby Seale and the late Edgar Seale, formerly served Precinct No. 1 as Justice of the Peace, and for the past ten years has been connected with the Lower Colorado River Electric Co-Operative in its right of way and tax division.
