Milton had worked for them last fall while killing turkeys as time keeper and in that way became familiar around the office and of course spled the cash drawer, which usually has money in it, sometimes a good bit and again not so much. Milton had been seen a few times around when it was known he had no business and suspicion was aroused. A trap was set for him once before but Milton disovered it and his plans for that day fell through. However, he waited for awhile and again the cash began to check up short, . One time \$40.00 was missing, another \$20.00 and at various times smaller amounts. Milton or who ever it was before, would not take all the money in the drawer but being a good burglar would split it, take about half and leave half. While Constahle Robinson, Fred Krauss and Monoe Seelke were at Milton's house at first, of course there was some argument when he so strongly said he had not gotten the money, and Monroe Scelke was there and told him he was ooking right at him, Milton's brother old John that the boy must have get en the money and tried to lay it off on him.
