Lone Star Gas Co.
Says No Gas Now For Lexington
T. W. Simmons, president of
the Lexington Chamber of Commerce, received a letter
his week from the Lone Star Gas Company at Dallas, indi-
cating that there is no imme
diate hope for natural gas to be piped into Lexington.
The letter, signed by A. P. Rowland, division superintend-
ent, states that a survey just
completed of the area indicated that not enough demand for
their product existed at this time to justify the construction
of a distribution system for Lexington.
Mr. Rowland added that the
company was hopeful that it would be possible to consider
piping natural gas to Lexington sometime in the future.
