TO STATE GAME PRESERVE

E. C. Knippa, president of the Fedor 4-H Club, Monroe Karcher, Lincoln 4-H, R. G. Buuck, Fedor 4-H club leader, and Jack Sloan, County Agent, attended the annual 4-H Wildlife Conservation Camp at Rockport, July 27. There were some 175 outstanding 4-H club boys from practically every section of the state in attendance.

The camp consisted of instructions on conservation of wildlife by some of the leading authorities of the state, a tour through the Federal Game Preserve, boating and fishing. The tour through the game preserve was probably the highlight of the camp. The preserve consists of some 47,000 acres and is stocked with over 3,500 deer, 600 wild turkies, 100 javalina hoge, and an abundance of quail. Many deer and turkeys were seen on the tour.
