**Dime Box Gins
First Lee Co. Bale**

Dime Box ginned this year's first Lee County bale of cotton Friday.

It was brought in to Dime Box by E. N. Spacek and was raised on the A. H. Spacek farm.

The weight of the bale which was ginned at the Arnold W. Han-

nes gin, was 510 pounds. It was bought by Frank Riske for 36c a pound.

The seed weighing 710 pounds was sold at \$52.00 per ton to Arnold W. Hannes. Spacek received the customary premiums paid to the farmer that brings in the season's first bale.
