R. Umlang of Lincoln was in Wednesday and in paying for a renewal said that he had gathered 13 bales of cotton from 33 acres and is well satisfied with his output. Mr. Umlang is one of the farmers who is doing well in Lee County and he feels that this part of the country is mighty good. He came to this county ten years ago and purchased a farm, paying only part cash for it. He has since paid for his farm and has spent at least \$2500 in improvements the past four years. Each year he adds some improvements. During 1921 he built a very large barn and he has just completed an addition to his residence. Mr. Umlang did not ask us to say this about him, in fact, he consented with reluctance when we asked if we could print it, but it shows that farmers in Lee County are prosperous as well as in other sections of the state.
