**NEW KIND OF CANE**

Lee Wall, hustling farmer of the Adina community, is trying his luck with a new variety of ribbon cane which he found in Alabama some few years ago when he was on a visit to his old home. The new variety is supposed to do well on poorer soils and takes the place of ribbon cane which grew only in the richer soils. Lee has a large patch this year which is his second year of growing it and he will not make syrup this year as he wants all the stalks for seed.

Lee has been doing much with melons and peanuts the past years and finds he is doing as well, if not better, than with cotton. He also plants plenty of feed crops.
