**GHS Graduate Named
To Houston University's
Football Team**

HOUSTON.—Leroy Wiese, 1947 Giddings high school graduate, is a member of the University of Houston football team.

A 205-pound fullback, Wiese took an active part in the Cougars' spring training drills. He is a junior physical education student in the university.

The 20-year-old Giddings boy is considered a valuable addition to the Cougar team. In the Cougars' second intra-squad game during the spring drills, Wiese scored three touchdowns for his team. He was frequently praised by fans, coaches, and sports writers for his play at the fullback spot.

This fall, University of Houston tackles the roughest schedule in its history, meeting such power-houses as St. Bonaventure (N. Y.), Baylor University, William and Mary, University of Wichita and Tulsa University. In 1951 and 1952 the Cougars add Alabama to their schedule and, in 1953, Georgia Tech will be on the list of opponents.

Fullback Wiese, who played four years for Giddings High, attended Schreiner Institute before coming to Houston. In high school he was team captain and all-district player.
