

Lutherans Set Campaign for More Buildings at Texas Lutheran College



SEGUIN—A state-wide financial campaign to provide additional buildings for Texas Lutheran College will open the week of June 11. New buildings included in the college's expansion plans are a women's dormitory, a gymnasium, a student union, and a chapel.

The cost of these buildings and of the proposed campus improvements is estimated at approximately \$500,000. Citizens of Seguin and Guadalupe County have raised \$83,000 for the proposed gymnasium.

Dr. A: G. Wiederaenders, vice-president of TLC and director of the College Development Association, recently reported 85 contributors had made pre-campaign gifts totaling approximately \$35,000. It is expected that 20,000 Texas members of the American Lutheran Church will contribute to the campaign.

The campaign for Texas Lutheran is part of the churchwide ingathering being conducted by the American Lutheran Church in the interest of its colleges and seminaries.
