This Texas Country Music group is based out of Huntsville and features the very talented Jerrett Zoch as lead singer. The O.S.R.

Band, which stands for Old San Antonio Road, was formed in May of 2010 by Zoch and his friends, Daniel Huggins, of Centerville who plays lead guitar and Berny Herrera of Jewett who keeps the beat steady on the drums. Bass player Logan Mehringer of Teague joined the fray in the summer of 2011 and the group has been playing gigs across Texas ever since.

While this band has an awesome arsenal of fan favored covers they flawlessly perform in concert, they also have some fabulous self-penned songs including "Pleasure," "Your Fool," "Never Grow Old," "Red Roses," "Kings and Queens," "Fireflies," and my personal favorites, "Don't Come Around" and "Stay."



Jerrett Zoch and the O.S.R. Band put on an awesome "live" performance and are great for both concert and dance hall settings. Hopefully they'll lay down some tracks in the studio soon to add to our digital playlist and CD collections.

This band is fast making a name for themselves, especially with their recent Battle of the Bands win that earned them a feature spot in the Backroads Musicfest to be held Saturday, Sept. 7, 2013 at the Nacogdoches County Expo Fairgrounds. This music festival will kick-off at 3 p.m. and will also feature Backseat Molly, Jason Cassidy, JB and the Moonshine Band, Roger Creager and Kevin Fowler.

Tickets are \$20 per person in advance at Baskins in Nacogdoches, Sound Techs in Lufkin and online at outhouse tickets.com. Tickets at the gate are \$25

per person. Gates open at 2 p.m. No coolers allowed. Full concessions and a beer garden will be running all night long on site. (Promoters are promising that there will not be any jacked up stadium pricing at this event.) Concessions will benefit the Melrose Volunteer Fire Department. Misting tents will also be available. Bring your lawn chairs, blankets or bales of hay for seating.
