American junior outside hitter Zeynep Uzen, Army West Point senior outside hitter Cate Buckingham, Bucknell freshman libero Jordan Hardy and junior outside Lisa Zoch, Loyola Sophie Brenner, and Navy senior right side Avery Stowell all earned honorable mentions.

Player of the Week

Katie Forsythe, Loyola Maryland, Sr., L, Perry, Ohio/Gilmour Academy

- * Forsythe averaged 7.44 digs per set (67 total) in the Greyhounds three games at the Old Dominion University Invitational. Loyola went 2-1 in the tournament.
- * The senior posted 26 digs in the opener against West Virginia, 19 digs on Friday in the 3-0 win over Hampton and then 22 digs in Saturday's 3-0 victory over Old Dominion.

Rookie of the Week

Diana Ethridge, Army West Point, Fr., S, Chanler, Ariz./Hamilton

- * Ethridge recorded 97 assists in Army's 3-0 weekend, with 39 assists against both Providence and Iona.
- * Against Merrimack, she had 19 assists and five service aces for the Black Knights.
- * The freshman setter was named to the Army Invitational All-Tournament team.

Honorable Mentions

Zeynep Uzen, American, Jr., OH, Istanbul, Turkey/TED Istanbul College

* Uzen tied her career-high with 19 kills while adding 19 digs in a five-set win at Georgetown on Friday.

Cate Buckingham, Army West Point, Sr., OH, San Antonio, Texas/Winston Churchill

* Buckingham finished Army West Point's 3-0 weekend with a .386 attacking percentage and 29 total kills. The senior recorded 12 kills against Providence, nine kills versus Merrimack and eight against Iona.

Jordan Hardy, Bucknell, Fr., L, Winter Park, Fla./Trinity Preparatory School

* Hardy posted double-digit digs in all three matches, including a high of 19 digs in a win over St. Francis Brooklyn.

Liza Zoch, Bucknell, Jr., OH, Columbia, Md./Atholton High School

* Zoch posted two double-doubles in a 2-1 weekend for Bucknell. The junior earned a career-high 21 kills, 13 digs and a .415 hitting percentage in a win over St. Francis Brooklyn, followed by 13 kills, 12 digs, a block solo and a block assist versus Delaware State.

Sophie Brenner, Loyola Maryland, Fr., OH, West Chester, Pa./Unionville

* Brenner recorded 17 kills on 33 attempts, posting just three errors for a .424 hitting percentage as the Greyhounds swept host Old Dominion. Brenner also had a double-double in the match with 16 digs.

Avery Stowell, Navy, Sr., RS, Yorba Linda, Calif./Esperanza

* Stowell led Navy with 40 kills and ranked second with nine blocks at the Baltimore Invite. The senior paced Navy with 16 kills and shared the team lead with five blocks versus Towson on Sunday.
