**Child With Lock Jaw**

Willie, the ten-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Walter Zweynemann of Lincoln, stuck a stick into his leg and it was thought that the entire stick had been removed. Eight days thereafter, last Sunday, the boy was taken with lock jaw and it was found that a portion of the stick five-eighths of an inch long and about three-eighths of an inch wide was still in the wound. Medical attention was given and a trained nurse was called to the case Sunday night.
