TWO KILLED IN CROSSING ACCIDENT

Two colored preachers were instantly killed Friday morning when the southbound passenger train collided with an automobile shortly after 11 a. m. at the crossing just north of Rabbs Creek. The men, one from Brenham and the other from Taylor, were returning from a convention at Winchester and it is said that the engine of the train hit the automobile in the center. When the train backed up to the place of the accident, the men were dead. One was pinned in the automobile and had to be pried out with a crowbar.
