CHURCH DEDICATION * IN BRENHAM

The gathering was composed of people from congregations far and near to join this young congregation in this grand occasion, it was organized in 1935 with the following members: 1. W. The building 30x60 is constructed of native stone, the altar and pu'pit of stone and petrified wood very artistically arranged, the walls and ceiling are of celetex and hardwood floer and make the inside very attractive. The church is lecated about seven blocks southwest of the Brenham High School, Rev. T. H. Graalmann is their first resident pastor, having been installed Feb. 9th last year.
