## DIME BOX H. D. CLUB

Some important points on "First Aid" were given in an instructive discussion by Mrs. August Spacek in the meeting of the Dime Box H. D. Club held at the home of Mrs. W. R. Standifer at 2:30 p. m. April 2.

When administering First Aid to an injured or sick person, the following points should be remembered:

- 1. Keep patient lying down.
- Look for hemorrhage, stoppage of breathing, burns, fractures, dislocations, poisons.
  - 3. Keep the patient warm.
- 4. Call physician or ambulance.
- Keep cool and do not be hurrled into moving the injured person.
- Never give an unconscious person water or any other liquid.
- Keep onlooker away from injured.
- Make patient comfortable and cheer him in any way possible.
- Avoid patient seeing his own injury.
