**FEDOR LUTH. CHURCH  
TO CELEBRATE 70TH  
ANNIVERSARY FEB. 23**

Trinity Lutheran Church at Fedor is looking forward to a Day of Jubilee which was set for the last Sunday in February. The congregation wants to commemorate the 70th Anniversary of its founding, and also the 65th Anniversary of the building of its church with three services on that day.

Pastor E. F. Moerbe, now retired from the ministry, a son of the congregation, has been asked to preach in the morning services. Pastor G. W. Fischer was requested to hold the sermon in the afternoon services. Pastor W. E. Dorre of Houston, who once was pastor of Trinity Congregation, was asked to preach in the Evening Services, which will be conducted in the English language.

The painting of the interior of the church is now about completed, giving the house of God a much more churchly appearance. A rebuilt tower, and a new roof were some of the major repairs necessary after these many years. That work has now been completed at a cost of more than \$800 which the congregation gathered last year. All the work has been paid, and a little surplus remains in the Building Fund. The congregation feels that it should express its gratitude to God in these services for His divine blessing upon such a large undertaking.
