Six members were present at this meeting with Mrs. Ed. C. Hamff, May 2. Among the many recipes given for aids in house cleaning the following will prove useful in cleaning papered walls: 1 1-3 c. flour, 1-2 c. warm water, 2 T. salt, 2 T. vinegar, 2 T. amonia, 1 T. kerosene. Mix flour and salt, add all liquid ingredients, cook in double boiler as long as able to stir or fold over, remove from pot, knead with hands until the mass is elastic, place in a covered can until cold. Use as any other wall dough, cleaning one strip at a time and folding dough over as the surface becomes soiled. Caution: Overlap the strokes.
