An election will be held at all voting places in Lee County

Dec. 27 to determine whether or not Lee County will accent and attach the territory ceeded and detached from Milam County described as follows: Beginning at S. W. corner of Milam Co., thence N. 60 deg. East, with the south line of Milam Co. it being the N. line of Lee County to the N. E. corner of Lee County. continuing this line between Milam and Burleson counties to a point on said line, it being the east boundary line of the David Houston League of land, thence N. 641/2 degrees W. to where this line intersects the right-of-way of the I. & G. N. R. R. Thence W. with the rightof-way to where it crosses Big Brushy Creek, thence up said Brushy with its meanderings to the W. boundary line of Milam County, it being the E. boundary line of Williamson Co., thence with the said boundary line S. to the beginning containing 107.63 sq. mi.
