Mr. Darter of the Giddings Manufacturing Company, which is now providing the electric lights, says that he can promise lights from now on as follows: Every Wednesday and Saturday morning the current will come on at 9 o'clock and continue all day and night. On all other days it will come on at noon and continue all day and night. Mr. Darter says that he hopes the service will be dependable from now on, that he has located and about corrected the defects which have been the source of the interrupted current to date, and he is doing all in his power to give the public good service. moving the former electric light equipment and installing it, which might cause some interruption, as is the case with all machinery which must be installed and tried out, but he will continue his efforts towaru giving Giddings as full and complete service as the town will support.
