NEW BUS THROUGH GIDDINGS

Louis Moritz, manager of the Kerrville Bus Company, left Tuesday for Detroit to bring back four new buses to be put into operation on the schedules between Austin and Houston about February 10th. Mr. Moritz took three drivers with him.

These buses are the "last word" in this type of equipment. Their total cost is approximately \$27,000. Of this amount, \$1600 represents the cost of a special type of reclining chairs which will add greatly to the comfort of passengers, and the velour upholstery and the interior finish of these buses make them, very attractive.

These buses are the latest type which have been produced. In fact, this particular model was produced for the first time about three months ago. Seating capacity of these coaches will be twenty-five passengers.

Mr. Moritz expects to be back with the new bases by Feb. 5th or 6th. They will be put into expect as soon as possible, and will replace the present type of car which is being used on this line.
