LIQUOR CAPTURED IN RAID

The raid by federal prohibition officers in Giddings Thursday of last week when five joints in the city limits were raided, resulted in confiscating 2283 pints of beer, 15 gallons of wine, 17 1-2 gallons of whiskey and 2 1-4 gallons of gin, besides 126 gal. of beer mash, 19 crocks from 8 to 12 gal. capacity, 726 empty beer bottles, four 5-gal. kegs, one 15-gal. keg, cappers, siphons and other equipment. Charges were filed against six white persons and one negro. The evidence was gained by a stranger visiting the speakeasies ten days or so before. The beer was being sold at 20 cents a pint bottle.
