BUS LINE FOR COLLEGE STUDENTS

Blinn College of Brenham will establish a bus line between Giddings and Brenham beginning in September. The bus will leave Giddings at 7:15 a. m. and return to Giddings at 5 p. m. About a dozen students of Giddings have already enrolled and these along with other students from Carmine and Burton will about make a bus full; however high school students living on the route will also be transported to the Brenham high school.

Blinn has already operated two busses, one from Caldwell and another from Wallis. Blinn is a State Aid Junior College offering the first two years of standard college work at a cost of \$163.00 per year to the student who lives at home and rides the bus. This is the total cost including bus fare, tuition and all fees. A Giddings boy will be employed as bus driver.
